The Society for Modeling & Simulation International (SCS) was established in 1952 as a nonprofit, volunteer-driven corporation called Simulation Councils, Inc. Simulation Councils, Inc. became The Society for Computer Simulation which is where we derived the acronym SCS before we changed once more to our current name. Today, we still keep the familiar SCS acronym as a part of our identity, but have given it a new & more relevant meaning: Simulate, Create, Serve. This SCS is not only who we are and what we do, but also who we serve.

Founded by John McLeod, SCS was designed to be a not-for-profit association founded for the primary purpose of promoting an understanding, appreciation, & utilization of computer-based modeling, simulation & related fields.

Today it is the premier international M&S society.
