An introduction by Potter's former business partner, Marshall Field, sparked a romance—and eventual engagement—between Potter and Bertha that led to perhaps one of the most extravagant wedding gifts of all time – Palmer House. On November 8, 1873, the new Palmer House welcomed its first guests, marking the opening of what would become the nation's longest continually operating hotel.

Not only does the hotel's central location in downtown Chicago offer visitors the chance to walk to famous attractions such as the Art Institute of Chicago, Millennium Park, and State Street Shopping, but staying at the Palmer House is an adventure by itself.

Upon entering the lobby guests are greeted with a breathtaking one-of-a-kind ceiling fresco by French painter Louis Pierre Rigal. Guests can take the hotel's History is Hott tour and join Palmer House Hilton historian Ken Price for lunch and an exclusive guided tour through this legendary Chicago landmark or enjoy many of the other things to do at the hotel.
