- Electronic versions of one page abstracts are due by June 30, 2001
- Notification of acceptance on July 15, 2001
- Electronic versions of papers (optional) are due by August 31, 2001
- Author Registration by August 31, 2001
- Early Registration fee before September 30, 2001 is \$125
- Normal Registration fee after September 30, 2001 is \$150

When accepted, submission of an abstract becomes a commitment to register, attend and make a presentation. Forms of payment: U.S. Check, VISA, MasterCard, Purchase Order and DD Form 1556. A booklet of abstracts and a CD version of the Proceedings are distributed at the conference. A hard copy of

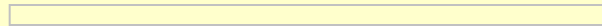

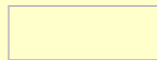
